ENTRY FEES AND DEADLINES:

IMPORTANT

- KEF Local Event Rules apply to this event. (available on kwfederation.com).
- All athletes must have an active KEF membership to be eligible to compete.
- Athletes in competitions (3-6) must be registered under a trainer, whose name will appear on the start and results lists.
- The trainer whose athletes achieve the highest number of placing (from 1st to 6th) in competitions 3-6 will receive the award.
- Maximum entries per horse in all competitions = two entries.
- Competition (7) format: each rider will jump 4-5 obstacles, then dismount and complete a bicycle course on a designated track. **Three winners will be awarded.**

RULES

- Entries not complying with registration rules will be removed from the lower competition without notice.
- Participants must respect competition schedules; late arrival may lead to disqualification.
- Obstacle heights and class divisions follow the official schedule and may only be changed with prior notice.
- Proper competition attire is mandatory.
- Prize money will be distributed to six (6) placed athletes.
- All disputes will be settled by the appointed jury according to the federation rules.
- No pets are allowed.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.

X. PRIZE MONEY DISTRIBUTION

Prize money will be distributed to the first 6 winners.



BEST COACH AWARD – POINT SYSTEM

Placing	Points
1 st place	50 points
2 nd place	40 points
3 rd place	30 points
4 th place	25 points
5 th place	20 points
6 th place	15 points

I. Rules:

- All riders must be officially registered under a coach.
- Points are awarded to the coach based on the rider's final placing, from 1st through 6th.
- If a coach has more than one rider placing in the same class, all earned points count.
- The Best Coach title shall be awarded to the coach who accumulates the highest total points from competitions 3 to 6.

II. Tie-Break Rules (No Ties Allowed)

If two or more coaches finish with the same total points, the tie will be broken in the following order:

- Highest number of 1st place results.
- If still tied, highest number of 2nd place results.
- If still tied, highest number of 3rd place results.
- If still tied, the coach whose rider achieved the highest placing in the highest-level class.
- If still tied, the decision will be made by the Organizing Committee.
